




Thru-Fastened Panels are the most economical option and are typically installed over solid decking (or existing shingle and furring strips for re-roof applications) and are attached with fasteners that penetrate through the metal panel into the structure below. Since the fasteners are visible, they are coated in colors that match the metal roofing panels. Popular thru-fastened panels for residential applications include Max-Rib, Mesa, and 5V.


Met-Tile is a thru-fastened panel that provides the appearance of ceramic tile with all the advantages and performance of metal. Also, Met-Tile is a panelized roofing system, which means installation takes a fraction of the time required for ceramic tiles. In fact, a single Met-Tile panel can cover the equivalent area of 80 individual ceramic tiles.

Concealed Fastener Panels are joined together by integral locking seams and are fastened to the deck with fasteners and/or clips that are hidden underneath the roofing panels. Popular concealed fastened panels for residential applications include Meridian and Medallion-Lok.
